RULES & REGULATIONS

- Pigeon must be clocked minimum of three times or more in the top 10 percent of birds competing in three separate races (different dates) to qualify. The more times you clock your bird in the top 10 percent the more points it will receive.
- Birds in competition with fewer than five lofts will qualify as long as there are a minimum of three lofts at three different locations participating in the race.
- Winners will be determined by formula. Base points are set up in each Hall of Fame category. Loft competition, distance, and amount of pigeons in race and birds entered in race by applicant are all part of the formula/program
- Deadline for submission of Old Bird entries is September 1st and for Young Birds, December 31st.
- Applicant must be paid up IF member by April 1st of year submitting for award.
- Winner in each category receives a trophy plaque.
- All race results must be mailed with application or your bird will be disqualified from entering H.O.F.
